


User manual for the app TalentLMS

Versjon 3.0.8

If you want to proceed the e-learning when you don't have access to Internet, or the network is slow and/or expensive, you can use the app TalentLMS. Remember to download the course-content when the unit is connected to Internet. The app is available for Android and iOS.


Download **the app TalentLMS** from Google Play / Apple App Store.

Domain= **asksafety.talentlms.com**
Type it here and tap "NEXT".



The user name is usually your email address.


Then type your password and tap "SIGN IN".




You will now see your progress for each course.

Tap the course you want to proceed or download.



Tap the download-symbol ("the cloud") to download the content.



Scroll down to allow the app to download content through the mobile network. «Download content only via Wi-Fi» is the default choice.

To do this, tap the download-symbol  as described on the previous page. When you do this, the device must be connected to Internet.

If you during the course would like to use a different computer / tab / phone, please tap the download-symbol  on the first device to save your progress. The device must be connected to Internet when you do this.
